SCHEDULE: Cast off at Greens Bridge Ramp 10:00 AM

1. Bob Johnston will do a shuttle from the takeout. He will arrive about 9:00 AM at I-5 boat ramp and leave by 9:30 AM for Greens Bridge ramp.
2. **Bring & wear mask** if using shuttle by Bob Johnston. You will not be 6 ft apart in vehicle. Saturday weather looks good, cloudy, and maybe a little rain.

Jon Beilstein & Glenn Tadina did a reconnaissance drift with Matt Halseth Saturday February 26, 2022. The water was low, however we had no trouble. We encountered no real hazards. We only had one spot where Matt pushed Jon and I (in the boat) through some low water. A few more inches and we would have been able to drift through. There were a few channel changes which did not present any problems. The school bus area was a dry gravel bed. A new channel goes basically straight to where the old channel would have come out.

With a little higher water, the drift would be better than what we had.

Brian Paulsen, Or. State Water Board was not able to go through the low water at the confluence with his jet boat to check hazard upstream. We had no problem navigating with the drift boat.
